Worry: (*Merminao*) – to dwell on, to think about; to be troubled or anxious

Main Points:

1. Worry is the result of a divided heart and mind.
2. Overcoming worry requires us to shift our eyes away from our circumstances and prioritize who God is and what he has done.
3. Worry will not protect us from tomorrow's problems, but it will rob us of today's joy.

Something to tweet/post: When the enemy uses my circumstances to overwhelm my mind with worry, I will look for the blessings of today and trust a faithful God for tomorrow.

Discussion Questions:

1. What impacted you the most from this week at Good News? What was your biggest takeaway?
2. What are the things in life that you tend to worry the most about?
3. In this passage, it is important to see what the "therefore" of verse 25 is talking about. So, we look back to verse 24. What foundation does that give us for better understanding the root cause of worry?
4. What role does our attachment to the things of this world, particularly the material things, play in our struggles with worry and anxiety?
5. How valuable is it to learn to shift our eyes from temporary, material things onto an eternal and faithful God? How does that help us with worry?
6. Worry is always ineffective and unproductive for us, yet it is a powerful tool of the enemy in attacking us. Why do we allow him to paralyze us and rob us of our joy with this tactic?
7. What are the keys that Jesus gives us in this passage to help us overcome paralyzing worry and anxiety? How can we help each other in our battle against worry?
